## IRS Releases Notice of Proposed Average Income Test Guidance Open for Comments by 12/29/2020

**Effective Friday, October 30, 2020,** the IRS published a notice of proposed guidance on the **Average Income Test (AIT) minimum set-aside**. Once finalized, the regulations would provide guidance on implementation of the AIT. Virginia Housing is reviewing the proposed guidance and will provide updates on our website.

The proposed regulations affect owners of low-income housing projects, tenants in those projects, and Virginia Housing, as the agency which administers the low-income housing tax credit.

The proposed regulations are open for public comment for 60 days, no later than **December 29, 2020**. Written comments can be submitted online using the **Federal eRulemaking Portal (reference IRS and REG-104591-18)**.
